

### Watch out for common Turkish speakers' mistakes in English!

Turkish learners often use **more** to form comparatives when they should use **-er**.

#### Get it right! Use:

- **-er** for adjectives with one syllable or two syllables when they end in **-y**.  
WRONG *They're more funny than the other programmes.*  
CORRECT *They're funnier than the other programmes.*
- **more** for most adjectives with two syllables and all adjectives with more than two syllables:  
WRONG *History is interestinger than maths.*  
CORRECT *History is more interesting than maths.*

Turkish learners sometimes use both **more** and **-er**.

#### Get it right! Use:

- **-er** or **more** but not both together.  
WRONG *Life is more easier than before.*  
CORRECT *Life is easier than before.*

Turkish learners sometimes forget to use the comparative form.

#### Get it right! Use:

- **-er** or **more** to compare two things or people.  
WRONG *Bora is young than his brother.*  
CORRECT *Bora is younger than his brother.*

Turkish learners sometimes make spelling mistakes with common adjectives.

#### Get it right! Use:

- the correct spelling:  
WRONG *beatiful, helthy, impertant, intresting*  
CORRECT *beautiful, healthy, important, interesting*
