

Watch out for common Turkish speakers' mistakes in English!

Turkish learners often make mistakes with the word order of Yes/No questions formed with *be*.

Get it right! Use:

- the correct word order for **Yes/No** questions:

WRONG ~~You are OK?~~

CORRECT **Are you OK?**

Turkish learners often use the wrong form of *be* in *Wh-* questions.

Get it right! Use:

- is*** before singular nouns and ***are*** before plurals:

WRONG ~~Where is your mother and father?~~

CORRECT **Where are your mother and father?**

Turkish learners sometimes forget to use *be* or *do* in questions.

Get it right! Use:

- be*** where there is no other verb and ***do*** with a different main verb:

WRONG ~~Where the station?~~

CORRECT **Where is the station?**

WRONG ~~When you watch these programmes?~~

CORRECT **When do you watch these programmes?**

Turkish learners often make mistakes with word order when they use adverbs of frequency such as *always*, *sometimes* and *often*.

Get it right! Use:

- the adverb after the person (*you*, *we*, *he*, etc.) and before the main verb. If the main verb is *be*, the adverb comes after it:

WRONG ~~You always should drink water.~~

CORRECT **You should always drink water.**

WRONG ~~We always are together at school.~~

CORRECT **We are always together at school.**

Turkish learners often write *every time* when the correct word is *always*.

Get it right! Use:

- always*** to speak or write about something that happens all the time:

WRONG ~~She is every time happy.~~

CORRECT **She is always happy.**
