

CAMBRIDGE ENGLISH: PRELIMINARY SPEAKING PRACTICE TEST

Part 1 (Interview)

(Begin by asking each candidate general questions using the prompts.)

- What's your name?
- How do you spell that?
- Where do you live?/Where do you come from?
- What subjects do you like at school? Why?
- Do you watch TV? What TV programmes do you like to watch? Why?

(Select one or more of the questions from the list to ask each candidate.)

- Do you play a musical instrument? (If so, what do you play? Do you play in a band?)
- What job would you like to do? Why? What qualities do you think you would need to do this job?
- Do you have rules for the amount of time you can spend on your smartphone, tablet or computer?
- Who do you admire most? Describe what sort of person he/she is and why you admire him/her.
- What rules do you have at home and at school? What happens if you break the rules?

Part 2 (discussion)

In the next part you are going to talk to each other.

I'm going to describe a situation to you.

A group of friends want to celebrate the end of school year. Talk together about the different things they can do and decide which is best.

On page 2 there are pictures with some ideas to help you.

Part 3 (extended turn)

Now I'd like each of you to talk on your own about something. I'm going to give each of you a photograph of people spending time outside.

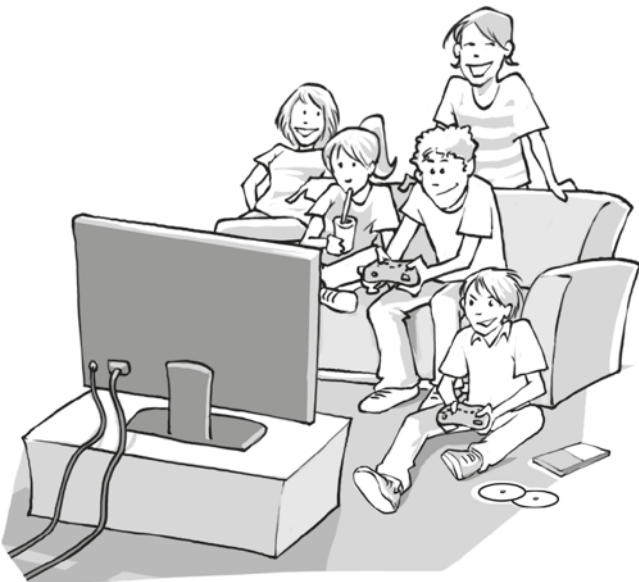
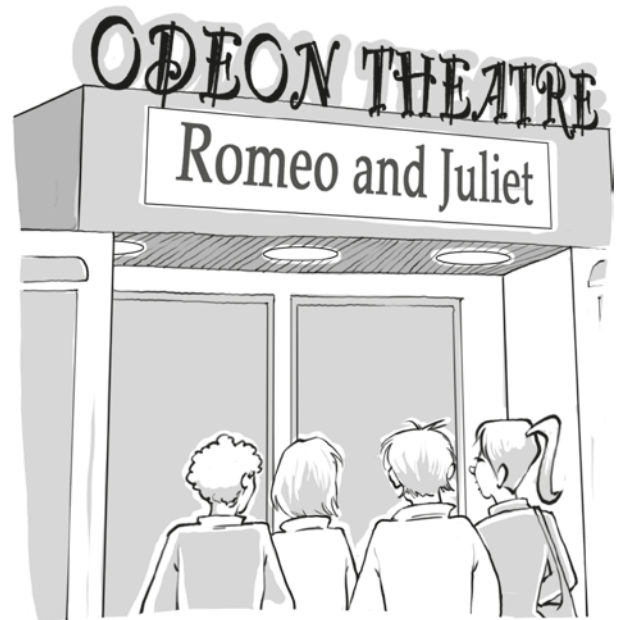
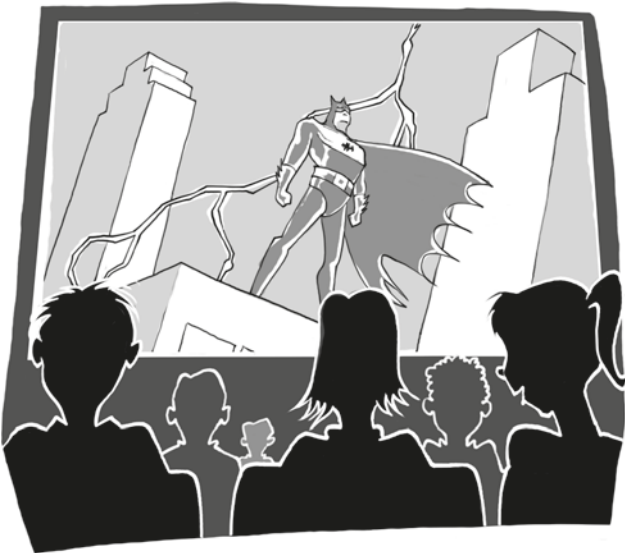
