Work in groups and follow the instructions. Debate the statement: *It's OK to tell a lie.* Note down your group's opinions and be prepared to share them with the class.

- Make a list of all the things Jeff did right and all the things he did wrong.
- Decide what the consequences of each action were.
- Rank his actions 1–5 where 1 = very wrong and 5 = completely right.
- Change part of the story, for example:
 - Mia tells Chloe that Jeff is lying.
 - Chloe and Jeff go to the cinema, but Chloe still thinks Jeff has done something to his wrist.
 - Chloe feels angry because Jeff lied.
